## SANITATION SERVICES GUIDELINES

### EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016

The following are guidelines provided by Industrial Disposal (ID) for the City of Watterson Park July 1, 2016, through June 30, 2018. If you have any questions, please call Industrial Disposal Customer Service at 638-9000.

• **CONTAINERS MUST BE AT CURB BY 6 A.M. ON SERVICE DAY.** •

**TRASH — Every Friday.** Put bagged trash in cart provided by ID and place at curb – NOT on the street. Place with wheels in the back facing the house and at least 3 feet from mailboxes, cars, landscaping, or any obstruction. All boxes should be broken down flat; large boxes should be cut down to 4-ft. sections. Trash service is for “normal” household trash – not demolition or construction materials. The following items will not be accepted: drywall, concrete, bricks, sinks, tubs, liquids, wet paint, pesticides, solvents, explosive items (i.e., oxygen tanks, propane tanks), bio-hazard materials (i.e., needles, sharps), tires or car parts, and items that contain Freon. If you need an additional cart, please call ID Customer Service at 638-9000.

**COMPOSTING — RESIDENTIAL HOMES ONLY — Every other Friday.** Includes grass, leaves, limbs, vines, small shrubs, and weeds. Beginning January 1, 2015, environmentally friendly, biodegradable/compostable bags will be the only types of bags permitted. Residents may still use self-enclosed containers, carts, and cans marked Yard Waste Only. Industrial Disposal will not pick up yard waste that is in a non-conforming bag. Tree limbs and branches: maximum 6 inches in diameter, no longer than 4 feet. Must be tied and bundled – not thrown loose at the curb. No loose dirt, stumps, firewood, fencing, landscape timbers, blocks, or decking.

**RECYCLING — Every other Friday.** Put items in recycle bin provided by ID. Acceptable materials: aluminum and metal cans; glass bottles; plastic #1 and #2; plastic bottles with a neck (soda bottles, laundry product containers, etc.); newspaper and magazines (please bundle or tie); corrugated cardboard/box board (i.e. cereal/soda/beer boxes and similar packaging). Not acceptable: plastic-coated paper; wrapping paper; waxed paper; window glass; light bulbs; ceramics; plastics other than products coded #1 or #2; cookware; hardcover books; polystyrene foam plastic (even if it has the recycling symbol); plastic bags; aluminum foil or foil pie pans. Place papers in the bottom, next plastics, and then glass to keep items from blowing away.

**Note:** Composting and Recycling will occur on the same alternating Fridays each month.

**JUNK —** Scheduled semi-annual large junk pick-up dates are: October 15, 2016; April 15, 2017; October 21, 2017; and April 21, 2018. No tires, paint, batteries, or any items that contain Freon will be picked up. In addition, ID will collect one junk item from a residence weekly as long as the resident has called ID in advance to schedule the pick-up. Additional charges MAY apply.

**HOLIDAYS —** If a scheduled service falls on an observed holiday (New Year’s Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day), service will be the day following the holiday. All services for the remainder of the week are also delayed one day.
