

# CITY OF WATTERSON PARK LEGISLATIVE MEETING

December 11, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

**Roll Call** — Roll was called. Present were Mayor Norman Liebert; Councilpeople Helen Arnold, Linda Chesser, Mary Ann Liebert, Joseph Welsh and Marlene Welsh; Treasurer Jerry Wild; and Clerk Aggie Keefe.

**Pledge of Allegiance** — All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Minutes** — A motion was made by Mrs. Arnold and seconded by Mrs. Welsh to approve the minutes of the November 13, 2013, meeting as received; all present voted yes (5-0).

**Treasurer's Report** — Mr. Wild reported receipts for the month of November 2013 in the amount of \$186,717.66 with expenditures in the amount of \$17,479.57, giving a surplus of \$169,238.09. Mrs. Welsh made a motion to approve the report as read; seconded by Mrs. Liebert. All present voted yes (5-0).

## OLD BUSINESS

**Camera Under Poplar Level Road Overpass** — Mrs. Chesser met at the overpass with Carrie Peers from Jim King's office as well as with Michael Hayes, President of Louisville Soccer. Ms. Peers will look into having cameras installed. She will also check into the possibility of installing some additional lighting and other options that would make the area safer. Ms. Peers will also have the debris and graffiti removed.

## New BUSINESS

### **Street Lights** —


Mrs. Chesser would like to get a street light installed in front of the Louisville Soccer Alliance property on an existing pole. Mayor Liebert will contact OOPS to schedule the installation.

Mrs. Chesser would also like to have street lights installed along Hodel Road; she is concerned about safety since that street is so dark at night. Mayor Liebert said that we would have to pay to have poles installed as well as monthly rental of the poles and lights, which would be a large expense. He said that Hodel Road doesn't have much traffic in the evenings. Mrs. Chesser asked if our City is liable if we do not light the area and a crime occurs. Mayor Liebert will contact John Treitz to find out if the City would be liable.
