

# CITY OF WATTERSON PARK LEGISLATIVE MEETING

October 8, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m.

**Roll Call** — Roll was called. Present were Mayor Norman Liebert; Council Members Helen Arnold, Linda Chesser, Gina Garrett, Mary Ann Liebert, Marlene Welsh and Lillian Wild; Treasurer Jerry Wild; and Clerk Aggie Keefe.

**Pledge of Allegiance** — All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Minutes** — A motion was made by Mrs. Welsh and seconded by Mrs. Wild to approve the minutes of the September 10, 2014, meeting as submitted; all present voted yes (6-0). A motion was made by Mrs. Wild and seconded by Mrs. Chesser to approve the minutes of the special meeting on September 12, 2014, as submitted; all present voted yes (6-0).

## OLD BUSINESS

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**Mailing List for Businesses and Residents** — Mrs. Keefe reported that she received a data file from United Mail containing the NCOA results. After removing duplicates and bad addresses, the list contains just under 400 good addresses. We will be able to use this list for future Watterson Park mailings.

**Pocket Calendars** — Some of the pocket calendars have been delivered to residents; the balance should be delivered within a week.

## NEW BUSINESS

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**Newsletter** — Mrs. Keefe would like to send out a newsletter with information on snow removal. She would also like to include another invitation to the businesses to be listed on our website. Mrs. Garrett will send Mrs. Keefe an article regarding the lower tax rate. Mrs. Chesser will submit an article and pictures from the Community Yard Sale as well as an article regarding spring 2015 Operation Brightside. Mrs. Chesser will ask Michael Hayse to send us an article about the new Louisville Soccer facility. All of this information should also go on our web site.

**First Kentucky Securities** — Stan Kramer and Ruth Webb from First Kentucky Securities arrived at 7:18 p.m. They talked about investment opportunities and strategies that could be beneficial to our City. They left the meeting at 7:40 p.m. Council agreed that we should discuss this further and go over it with Attorney Treitz before making any decisions.

**Treasurer's Report** — Mr. Wild reported receipts for the month of September 2014 in the amount of \$4,567.39 with expenditures in the amount of \$35,299.67, giving a deficit of \$30,732.28. Mrs. Arnold made a motion to approve the report as read; seconded by Mrs. Wild. All present voted yes (6-0).

**Property Taxes** — Mrs. Chesser had the following question regarding the insurance premium tax: Can someone who owns property in Watterson Park but is renting it out pay the associated insurance premium tax to the city in which he or she lives rather than to Watterson Park? We will address this with Attorney Treitz at the next meeting.

**Yard Sale** — Mrs. Chesser reported that yard sale signs will be going up this evening.

**No Solicitation Signs** — Mrs. Arnold asked about the possibility of providing "No Solicitation" signs for residents.




**ADJOURNMENT**
