The meeting was called to order at 6:03 p.m.

Roll Call — Roll was called. Present were Mayor Pro-Tem Linda Chesser; Council Members Helen Arnold, Scott Frisch, Gina Garrett, Mary Ann Liebert, and Marlene Welsh; Treasurer Jerry Wild; and Clerk Aggie Keefe.

Vacancy in the Office of the Mayor — Council discussed the opening created by Mayor Liebert's recent resignation and the need to fill that position in a timely manner. Mrs. Chesser said that the individual must be at least 21 years of age, a registered voter, and a resident of the City of Watterson Park. Council members agreed that whoever takes over the remaining 13 months of Mayor Liebert's term will need support from all of the members and officers of the City Council, and all agreed to provide any support necessary for his or her success.


After lengthy discussion, it was the consensus of the Council that Linda Chesser is the best candidate to fill the mayoral vacancy. Mrs. Chesser said it would be an honor to serve as Mayor and accepted the nomination. She stated that she cares deeply about the safety and welfare of our residents and businesses and that as Mayor she will strive to continue moving the City forward.

We will need a motion and vote at the December 9, 2015, meeting, after which Mrs. Chesser will be sworn in. This will create a vacancy on the City Council that will need to be filled.
